**June 27-July 1 – Week 3: Alice in Wonderland**

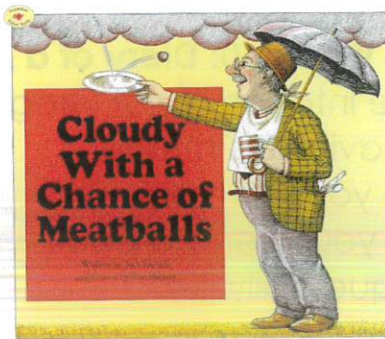
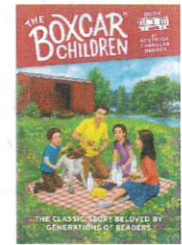
Take a trip through the looking glass! Have a tea party with the Mad Hatter and the March Hare! Let's get creative and silly as we explore Wonderland together!

# Stepping Stones Summer Camp

## Attendance and Tuition Policies

In order to better staff for summer camps and plan activities accordingly, we have instituted the following policies regarding attendance and tuition.

1. Campers must enroll for 5 day, 4 day, or 3 day weeks. The number of days a week your camper attends can be changed from week to week when filling out your enrollment form. Drop-ins, however, will not be permitted.
2. Payment must be received at the **BEGINNING** of each week.
3. You **WILL be charged** for the camp weeks you sign-up for unless you give a week's notice that your plans have changed (email or phone notice is fine).
4. Payment arrangements must be made prior the first week of camp so weekly **ACH can be set up.** If necessary, **debit/credit card** payments may be made at the office or by phone. Those who already have current ACH or credit cards on file need not provide new account information. Your weekly amount will be adjusted according to the sign-up sheet.
5. Two weeks without payment will result in termination from our summer camp program.
